

## **EAR CROP CONSENT FORM**

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I understand that during the performance of the foregoing procedure(s) or operation(s), unforeseen conditions may be revealed that necessitate an extension of the foregoing procedure(s) or operation(s) or different procedure(s) or operation(s) than those set forth above. Therefore, I hereby consent to and authorize the performance of such procedure(s) or operation(s) as are necessary and desirable in the exercise of the veterinarian's professional judgment.
I also hereby acknowledge that I understand that there are no guarantees either expressed or implied that the procedures authorized will be without complications from unexpected events beyond the veterinarians and hospital's control.
I authorize the use of appropriate anesthetics, and other medications, and I understand that hospital support personnel will be employed as deemed necessary by the veterinarian. I understand personnel is only on site during business hours.
I have been advised as to the nature of the procedure(s) or operation(s) and risks involved. I realize that results cannot be guaranteed and that aftercare is of utmost importance. I understand that post-operative taping is essential to the outcome of the procedure. I understand risk, benefits and alternatives. I have read and understand this authorization and consent.
Payment is due in full for services upon discharge of the Pet. Deposit may be required.
INTRA-OPERATIVE – Due to the young age of the patients undergoing ear crop surgeries, intra-operative fluids are mandatory. This is to normalize blood pressure and speed excretion of anesthesia from the body, thereby decreasing risk associated with anesthesia. The cost of intra-operative fluids has been included in the quoted price.
PRE-ANESTHESIA BLOOD SCREEN – Helps to evaluate Pet's ability to tolerate anesthesia by checking organ systems. The cost of the blood screen is not included in the quoted price of the procedure(s) or operation(s). Current price: \$52.35.  ACCEPT DECLINE
PRE-ANESTHESIA ECG – A pre-anesthetic heart screen allows us to better assess risk for any abnormalities in the heart that bloodwork and/or exam doesn't show. While any pet may have a problem, Boxers, Dobermans, Great Danes, Cavaliers and Main Coon cats are at a particularly high risk. This pre-anesthetic heart screen is not included in the quoted price of the procedure(s) or operation(s). Current price: \$15.00  ACCEPT DECLINE
MICRO-CHIPPING — Optional service performed at a discounted rate if done while Pet is under anesthesia. The cost of this service is not included in the quoted price of the procedure(s) or operation(s). A microchip is inserted under the skin and contains a unique ID number that is linked to your contact information in a national database. The microchip is extremely helpful in locating Pet owners should the Pet become lost. Current price while sedated: \$40.00  ACCEPT DECLINE
PREVICOX – Medication that helps to decrease inflammation and helps with pain management. The cost of this medication is not included in the quoted price of the procedure(s) or operation(s). In most cases this is a secondary medication and a primary pain medication will be sent home with the Pet. Current cost range: \$12.00 - \$20.00  ACCEPT DECLINE
SEDATIVES – Medication that helps to keep the pet calm after the procedure. The cost of this medication is not included in the quoted price of the procedure(s) or operation(s). Current cost range: \$12.00 - \$22.00  ACCEPT DECLINE
